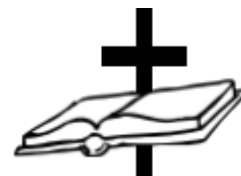


Sanborn Christian School Homenote November 10, 2022

Thanksgiving Feast: We will be remembering our gracious God at SCS with a Thanksgiving meal on **Wednesday, November 16** which is for our students, teachers, staff, and regular volunteers. The cost of each meal is \$3.00 that can be paid in advance in the office.**

If you do not sign up for a time, a conference time will be given to parents with kids in K-8th grade. Preschool parents are not required to have Fall Conferences but may request one, if there is a need. **Please sign up for your conferences by Monday, November 14.** If you have any questions or problems with the link, please contact the office. Please take this time to discuss the progress of your child(ren) with their teacher(s).

No School: Just a reminder there will be NO SCHOOL on Friday, November 18.

Report Cards: Report cards for grades 1-8 and progress reports for PK and Kindergarten have been emailed to parents. Please sit down with your children to discuss the report cards and their progress. Just a few bits of information to help with understanding how attendance works on JMC:

Absent Unexcused: Student gone without parent informing the school

Absent Excused: Student gone with parent informing the school

Tardy Unexcused: Students are late getting to class on time (ex. messing around in the bathroom)

Tardy Excused: Students are gone from school for a short period of time (ex. doctor appt., ortho, etc.)

Students in Grades 4-8 will also be coming home with a manila envelope that has report card related information for parents to look at with their children. Please ask your 4th-8th grader for this envelope. There is some material that needs to be signed and returned. This item can be returned at Parent-Teacher Conferences or sooner.

Thanksgiving: School will dismiss Wednesday, November 23 at 11:30 for the Thanksgiving holiday. The buses will run their normal route. No lunch will be served that day. There will be NO SCHOOL on Thursday, November 24 and Friday, November 27 due to the Thanksgiving Break.
