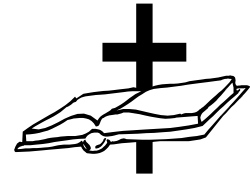

NICSTO Applications: For those who would like to send in an application for the NICSTO program, the applications will be due to the office no later than Monday, June 3. These applications must be based upon 2018 tax information and must be accompanied with a copy of the 1040 – line 22 to be considered. Job Openings at Sanborn Christian of 2019-2020:

1) **Part-time assistant cook** - this position is about 2-3 hours per day, and works alongside the head cook in terms of final meal preparations, serving lunch, and clean up afterwards. For more details, and for an application, contact the office at 729-3288.

2) **Part-time Jr. High teacher** - to work with students in grades 5-8 every day, probably in the afternoon. Classes which are to be taught is dependent upon the overall class schedule, but might include spelling, history, and various sections of science. For more details, and for an application, contact the office at 729-3288.

3) **Part-time preschool teacher** - this position is a 30% position and would be the lead teacher. Preschool classes are scheduled for Monday, Wednesday, and Thursday mornings from 8:30am to 11:30am. Various preschool requirements are to be in place prior to the school year starting in August. 4) **Part-time janitor / custodian** - this position requires about 25-30 hours a week (typically in the afternoon and evening) and has the responsibility of caring for the entire school building. To have interested parties involved in the summer cleaning process (June, July) would be a great benefit to the new janitor / custodian. 5) **Part-time preschool aide** - depending on the incoming preschool enrollment, SCS is looking for an aide (3 hours a day from 8:30 to 11:30am) to assist the lead preschool teacher. The necessity of this position is dependent upon the incoming enrollment.
