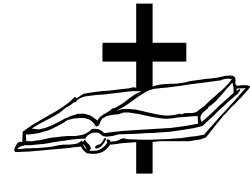


Sanborn Christian School Homenote

Dear Parents,

JOB OPENINGS AT SANBORN CHRISTIAN FOR 2019-2020:

- 1) **Part-time Jr. High teacher** - to work with students in grades 5-8 every day, probably in the afternoon. Classes which are to be taught is dependent upon the overall class schedule, but might include spelling, history, and various sections of science. For more details, and for an application, contact the office at 729-3288.
- 2) **Part-time head cook** - this position entails, but is not limited to: planning menus, ordering / picking up food, preparing meals for the student body, and overseeing the assistant cook position. General hours at school would be approximately 7:30am to 1:00pm on school days. For more details, and for an application, contact the office at 729-3288.
- 3) **Part-time assistant cook** - this position is about 2-3 hours per day, and works alongside the head cook in terms of final meal preparations, serving lunch, and clean up afterwards. For more details, and for an application, contact the office at 729-3288.
- 4) **Part-time janitor / custodian** - this position requires about 25-30 hours a week (typically in the afternoon and evening) and has the responsibility of caring for the entire school building. It would be a great benefit to have interested parties involved in the summer cleaning process (June, July) to a small degree to see how that all functions. - 5) **Part-time preschool aide** - depending on the incoming preschool enrollment, SCS is looking for an aide (3 hours a day from 8:30 to 11:30am) to assist the lead preschool teacher. The necessity of this position is dependent upon the incoming enrollment.
