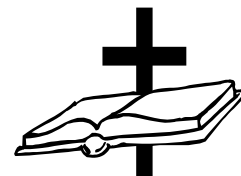

Dear Parents,

Mid-term reports will be sent home today. Grades K-3 will be sent home with the youngest student in each family. Please make sure to check their folder/bags for that.
