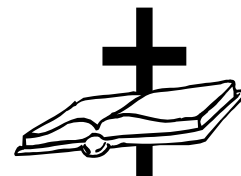


Sanborn Christian School Homenote September 13, 2018



Dear Parents,

Reminder: Just a quick reminder that next Tuesday, September 18, school will be dismissed at 1:15 pm for the teachers to work on curriculum mapping.

Safety Concern: We have had some comments on how children are riding their bikes and/or walking in the middle of the street and not stopping to look for oncoming traffic at intersections. Please make sure your children understand that they need to walk/ride on the sidewalks or on the side of the road, not in the middle of the road. And to also watch out for oncoming traffic. A reminder to the parents and students of the dress code for SCS. Students should strive to present a positive appearance at all times. Shorts may be worn, but should be longer length shorts. No biking shorts. All slogans, products, etc. on clothing must not be offensive to Christian good taste. No bare midriffs are allowed. Any student who does not dress appropriately may be sent home or parents called to bring alternative attire, at our discretion.
