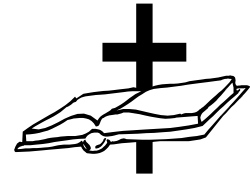


Sanborn Christian School Homenote September 17, 2020

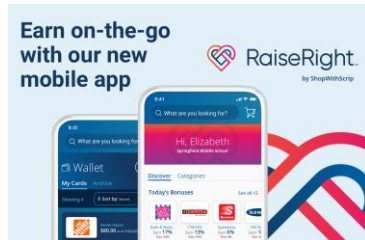
