Principal's Pen

As for many people, the Black Hills of South Dakota were a stop for our family for a few days in August. As we hiked in a few different places, we had the opportunity to see God's wonderful creation up close: mountains, rocks, trees, caves, deer, and mountain goats to name a few. For most of our family, hopping from rock to rock, like a frog leaping from lily pad to lily pad, was the welcomed challenge as they attempted to cross streams of water without slipping into the water along our hiking trails. Once wet, with the reason to stay dry gone, the stream itself became their hiking path.

Watching the kids in the water, climbing rocks, and doing my best not to slip into the cold water was enjoyable. Watching the water move over and around the rocks, like watching the flames of a fire at night, always seems to catch my attention too. Watching long enough, it appears that water never seems to exert any effort to flow in, around, and through the terrain.

That experience, coupled with the preparation of school this month, and the anticipation of a calendar full of various responsibilities, reminded me of a quote: "Not overwork, but overflow". I was initially hesitant about this quote because it seemed to rub against our general desire to work hard and long to strive to accomplish the full day's work. I alone need to complete the to-do list.

The context of this quote, however, comes in a few paragraphs that discuss that straining and striving alone does not accomplish the work that God gives us to do. God has established us where we are in order that He can work through us accomplishing the tasks that He has prepared in advance for us to do. A key concept for us as we anticipate full schedules in the near future is to restfully trust in Him, and to diligently apply ourselves to the tasks placed before us...and to overflow while doing it.

I believe the author of the quote was trying to draw a



connection to Psalm 127:1,2 and Psalm 90:17. We need to plan, work, and execute the details but ultimately God blesses the work of our hands and without that we labor in vain.

It's a good reminder that it's maybe not always about the workload, but *how* the workload is accomplished. Remember to produce Fruit in overflowing measures within the work. It's an intentional desire becoming natural and effortless when done with regularity. Like water what weaves, and bubbles, and overflows around the landscape with no straining or great effort and is quietly irresistible to watch, so should it be for an overflowing life on our part.

As school begins it's a good reminder to me that the work before us all (teachers, students and parents) is important, but the overflowing Godly character in which it is accomplished is essential.

School Board Highlights – August

August 8, 2022

President, Aaron Hoftzyer opened with devotions and prayer.

Agenda for the meeting, and past minutes, were approved.

Mr. Minderhoud gave the administrators report for information.

Education Committee reported on their August 2 meeting.

Karin Donovan will be replacing Lisa Den Hartog as the head librarian.

Amber Stange and Kari Van Beek will be our volleyball coaches for the upcoming season.

Building Committee reported on recent work: Jr. High bathroom remodel continues as planned; all the new TVs, mounts, and whiteboards are installed in the Jr. High classrooms, retaining wall north of the school was replaced by Alan Visser.

Building Committee reported on a received application and completed interview for the janitor position. Motion made to offer contract to this Ana Tovar.

Bus Committee reported on the possibility of replacing Bus 02 with a different bus.

Bus inspection is scheduled for August 17, 2022.

Bus Committee is still interested in securing more bus drivers.

Promotion Committee reported on our involvement in Railroad Days. Thanks to Arlen Hofman for driving the SCS bus replica in the parade.

Promotion Committee reported that Aaron Alons will be joining the Harvest Sale Committee.

Finance Committee reported on the August 4 meeting. The checking account balance of \$237,829.44 which includes tuition paid at Registration Night and funds from NICSTO. Sanborn Christian's average monthly expenses total \$80,521.57 for a 12 month period (July 2022 – June 2023).

The SCS NICSTO fund has received \$9,001 so far in 2022. We have the ability to receive \$84,887 by December 1, 2022.

An additional \$9,416.03 was received to offset the building debt. The remaining debt is \$89,995.00.

The 2022-2023 budget was passed at the June society meeting. No fairshare increase. An increase of \$450 increase to tuition.

CSI approved the 2022 school improvement plan.

Board / Staff supper is scheduled for August 17.

Monthly prayer lists were exchanged among board members.

A brief Board orientation night was held on August 3 for new and current Board members.

SCS is looking for a maternity leave sub for Mrs. Moss.

SCS is looking to expand the substitute teacher list.

Retiring board members were excused from the meeting and thanked for their years of service.

New board committees were formed. Executive Committee consists of: Brent Koldenhoven (President), Quint DeGroot (Vice President), Brent Vander Werff (Secretary), and Jon Hoogers (Treasurer).

Mr. Minderhoud will be serving on the CSI Accreditation Team that will be working at Inwood Christian during September 27-29, 2022.

No board policies were reviewed this month.

Mr. Brent Koldenhoven closed the meeting in prayer.

Next regularly scheduled Board meeting will be September 12, 2022.

Building Debt Update

We continue to keep in front of the society the financial end of this expansion. The total spent on the building was \$3,335,935 along with a \$200,000 contribution to the Foundation which brought the total expense to \$3,535,935 (not including interest accruals). The following is a chart to help you see the great progress that we have had in paying off this project:

Our unpaid balance is under \$90,000! We are very thankful for the financial support received at this point in the project, and we continue to ask that you continue to watch these numbers as we report them monthly, and prayerfully consider opportunities to continue to help us reduce the debt and complete this project.

NICSTO Tax Credit

(Northwest Iowa Christian School Tuition Organization)

Explanation for DONORS

The state has recognized the need to support taxpayers who wish to support Christian education. Iowa taxpayers can receive a tax credit up to **75% of their donation** that supports families who need tuition assistance and deduct the gift on Federal Income Tax. **How does it work?**

1. You must owe Iowa state income tax.
2. You must make out a check to NICSTO (Northwest Iowa Christian School Tuition Organization) and designate it to Sanborn Christian.
3. Complete the "Contribution Memo" and send it with the check to Sanborn Christian.
4. NICSTO will send you a letter of receipt for your Federal Tax information.
5. In early January, you will receive a tax credit certificate to attach to your Iowa tax form.

Example: If you contribute \$1,000 to NICSTO, you will receive a **75% tax credit** or \$750 on your IA income tax. In addition, you may claim some of that on your federal income tax.

Your money will be used for families who qualify for NICSTO at Sanborn Christian School.

Would you like to have your Iowa income taxes go to Sanborn Christian to help with the tuition scholarships AND pay down the building debt at the same time...or for it to go to Des Moines?

If you have an IA income tax liability of \$750, you could give \$1,000 to NICSTO which would then provide SCS with that \$1,000 to be used for tuition scholarships. Then when you do your tax work in March/April, you will receive a tax-credit of \$750 from the State of Iowa. You could then give this \$750 refund to Sanborn Christian to help eliminate the debt on our school. Sanborn Christian benefits by \$1,750 through a \$1,000 gift: \$1,000 to NICSTO, \$750 to building debt.

For those who are at least 70.5 years old, we encourage you to give from your IRA (you may use your RMD) to NICSTO. If you give \$1,000 from your IRA you do not need to include it as taxable income on your return. SCS receives that \$1,000 for NICSTO tuition scholarships, plus you will receive a state income tax credit of \$650 that you can use to help SCS eliminate the remaining building debt. Once again, SCS benefits by \$1,650 on a \$1,000 gift!!

Really?

Yes! The NICSTO program has been around for years and has been a benefit to both the recipient (SCS) and the donor (you). **This is a great tax benefit to those who will be paying taxes on their income.**

If you wish to donate, please fill out the donor sheet (included in the School Bell) and return it to SCS by December 1, 2022.

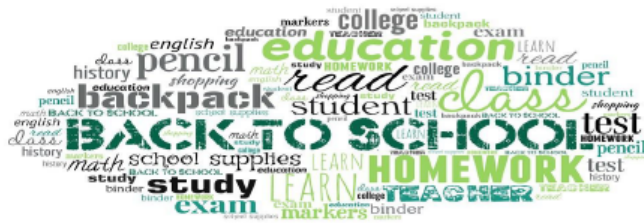
