
Sanborn Christian School Homenote August 24, 2023

Summer Reading Slips: Summer Reading Slips are due **TOMORROW**, **August 26**! Summer reading slips that are not turned in on time will not be accepted this year. Sorry!

ESAs - Earlier this summer you, as families, needed to select Sanborn Christian as the school your child is attending. Then SCS needed to enter the tuition amount for the school year. This prompted another move that was needed from you as a family. The next step is to log back into your ESA Odyssey account and accept that tuition amount. This will get half of the ESA funds into your account, and then it will move those funds to Sanborn Christian for your tuition. If you have not completed this last step, please log back into your ESA Odyssey account and complete the last step. According to Odyssey and the DOE, September 30 / October 1 is the deadline to accept the tuition amounts. If the tuition amount is not accepted by that date, the ESA funds will not be available to you, and you will miss out on the ESA funds for your children.
