

Principal's Pen

It's the middle of June and things are quiet in the school building at this point of the summer.

Other than some teachers popping in from time to time to get a few things, or to work on summer classes, or some summer cleaning being done, there isn't as much daily activity in the building as normal.

However, behind the scenes, things are quite busy as preparations for next school year are moving along.

ESAs (Education Savings Accounts) are still a big topic. The application process opened on May 31. According to Governor Reynolds' Twitter page, over a thousand applications were submitted in the first 30 minutes. There were over 5,000 applications submitted by the end of the first day, and there were over 10.000 applications in less than 72 hours. It appears that the response to the Students First ESA

program has been overwhelming.

I'm guessing that some of our Sanborn Christian families were part of those early numbers. If you were not part of those numbers, and you are intending on applying for an ESA, please be aware that June 30 is the deadline. Late applications will not be accepted by Odyssev and the DOE (Odyssey is the company that the state has signed a contract with to manage the program administration). So far, things appear to have gone smoothly.

NICSTO applications also came in quickly as the month of May ended.

Our Auxiliary is working hard on the June 24 golf tournament / steak supper and the July 22 5k and Fun Run.

We look forward to meeting with potential new incoming families within the month of June as well. This is our regular practice as we anticipate the possibility of partnering



with new families who are interested in Sanborn Christian and Christian education in general.

And then, of course, there is the annual Society meeting which is scheduled for June 28. You will see some reminders for this meeting in this School Bell edition, but no detailed information. This information has been arranged in a packet which you will find within your church mailboxes or emailed to you.

I continue to request that you continue to remember Sanborn Christian in your prayers this summer. Although it appears that things are quiet as you drive past the building, there is still a lot of activity happening to help prepare for the coming school year on August 23.

June 12, 2023

Polices from the Board Handbook were reviewed.

Building Debt Update

We continue to keep in front of the society the financial end of this expansion. The total spent on the building was \$3,335,935 along with a \$200,000 contribution to the Foundation which brought the total expense to \$3,535,935 (not including interest accruals). The following is a chart to help you see the great progress that we have had in paying off this project:

Our unpaid balance is under \$40,000! We are very thankful for the financial support received at this point in the project, and we continue to ask that you continue to watch these numbers as we report them monthly, and prayerfully consider opportunities to continue to help us reduce the debt and complete this project.

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Sanborn Christian's 10th Annual Summer of 2023 Reading Program

(TRACKING MINUTES)

If you've been part of our Summer Reading Program over the past 9 years, you'll notice that this sheet looks much different. That's because we've made some changes to the program.

- A major change is instead of tracking pages, we plan on tracking minutes this summer. This is more consistent with our two Reading Weeks that are imbedded into our school year.
- A second change is that all students (K-8) are shooting for the same goals. The reading goals are not separated by grade levels as they have been in the past. Again, this is like our Reading Weeks.

Here are some other things to consider and to follow:

- Students entering 2nd grade in the fall should be reading independently. This will continue to help them grow in the skills they have been working on during the past year in 1st grade.
- Connected to the first point, parent/student paired reading for students entering Kindergarten and 1st grade in the fall would be appropriate as they are in the learning stages. However, see if there can be times where it would be appropriate for the child to read to you so you can hear how it is progressing.
- The books can be new ones or old favorites. Please read at your reading level.
- On the following sheet, please track how many minutes you read this summer. <u>Tracking the author and titles of the books are not necessary</u> but you are welcome to do that if you so wish. If you fill the sheet on the back, add your own home-made sheet!! <u>Be sure to have Mom or Dad sign the bottom of the sheet and list the TOTAL of minutes!</u>
- Turn your sheet in to your homeroom teacher when school starts. <u>The LAST day to turn this in is Friday, Aug. 25</u> (school begins on Aug. 23!). <u>We will NOT accept Summer Reading Papers that come in after the due date.</u>
- If you read at least 1,050 minutes, you will receive a chocolate/candy bar treat of your choice. You can also earn a prize and a free book of your choice (there may be some restrictions on the free book, such as content, cost, etc.). ©

NICSTO Tax Credit (Northwest Iowa Christian School Tuition Organization)

Explanation for DONORS

The state has recognized the need to support taxpayers who wish to support Christian education. lowa taxpayers can receive a tax credit up to 75% of their donation that supports families who need tuition assistance and deducts the gift on Federal Income Tax. How does it work?

- 1. You must owe lowa state income tax.
- 2. You must make out a check to NICSTO (Northwest Iowa Christian School Tuition Organization) and designate it to Sanborn Christian.
- 3. Complete the "Contribution Memo" and send it with the check to Sanborn Christian.
- 4. NICSTO will send you a letter of receipt for your Federal Tax information.
- 5. In early January, you will receive a tax credit certificate to attach to your lowa tax form.

Example: If you contribute \$1,000 to NICSTO, you will receive a 75% tax credit or \$750 on your IA income tax. In addition, you may claim some of that on your federal income tax.

Your money will be used for families who qualify for NICSTO at Sanborn Christian School.

Would you like to have your lowa income taxes go to Sanborn Christian to help with the tuition scholarships AND pay down the building debt at the same time...or for it to go to Des Moines?

If you have an IA income tax liability of \$750, you could give \$1,000 to NICSTO which would then provide SCS with that \$1,000 to be used for tuition scholarships. Then when you do your tax work in March/April, you will receive a tax-credit of \$650 from the State of Iowa. You could then give this \$750 refund to Sanborn Christian to help eliminate the debt on our school. Sanborn Christian benefits by \$1,750 through a \$1,000 gift: \$1,000 to NICSTO, \$650 to building debt.

For those who are at least 70.5 years old, we encourage you to give from your IRA (you may use your RMD) to NICSTO. If you give \$1,000 from your IRA you do not need to include it as taxable income on your return. SCS receives that \$1,000 for NICSTO tuition scholarships, plus you will receive a state income tax credit of \$750 that you can use to help SCS eliminate the remaining building debt. Once again, SCS benefits by \$1,750 on a \$1,000 gift!!

Really?

Yes! The NICSTO program has been around for years and has been a benefit to both the recipient (SCS) and the donor (you). This is a great tax benefit to those who will be paying taxes on their income.

If you wish to donate, please fill out the donor sheet (included in the School Bell) and return it to SCS by December 1, 2023.
